### **Activities**

**Multi-Activities** A selection of activities that could include archery, crate stacking, orienteering, rifle shooting, challenge wall, team challenges and mountain biking.

**Bushcraft and Survival Skills** Spend the day in our woods learning to light fires, build shelters and find food

**High Ropes and Climbing** Test yourself on our high ropes course, zip wire and high "All Aboard". Have a go at climbing and abseiling on our indoor and outdoor walls.

**Water Sports** A fun-filled day on our lake. Learn new skills and play lots of games! The day will be a combination of kayaking, canoeing, stand-up paddle-boarding and raft building.

**Peak District Day** Spend an action-packed day in the beautiful Peak District climbing, squeezing and jumping your way through the Roaches Boulder Garden, before heading underground into one of the area's many caves and abandoned mines. Transport provided from the Centre.

Please note that all activities are subject to change for reasons such as weather or group abilities.

#### Prices

Each day is still only £25 per child. Book any four for £90 (must be booked and paid for at the same time). If you would like to book an early drop off - between 8:15am and 9:15am - this will be an additional £3.50.

### **How to Book**

Fill in the page opposite by ticking the boxes next to the activities you wish to book. Return the form to Stanley Head with a cheque made payable to Stoke-on-Trent City Council. Make sure you enter a correct email address so that we can confirm your booking and send you further details.

We can now take card payments over the phone **but** you must still post or email a completed booking form to confirm your place.

### **Times**

All days start at 9:15 and finish at 16:00. Please ensure that you are able to drop off and collect your child at these times.

### Lunch

Please bring your own lunch and drinks for the day.

# Clothing

Wear old clothing that you don't mind getting dirty and potentially wet. Old trainers that can be done up properly are ideal, or walking boots/trail shoes. Bring a few layers (even if it's really warm), sun cream, a sun hat, and waterproofs if it looks like rain! For the water sports day, a FULL change of clothes is essential, and a plastic bag for bringing home wet clothing.
